A Campus Designed for Diverse Learners

Heron School's campus is thoughtfully designed to facilitate varied learning experiences, offering distinct environments that cater to different educational needs and interests:

The Schoolhouse:

This central hub has several unique classrooms (traditional lecture, seminar, and versatile learning), a dining area, a kid's kitchen, an activity room, a sensory room, a sun porch library, a commercial kitchen, a laundry room, three apartment rooms - each with their own bathroom, two outdoor patios, and greenspace for outdoor learning and play. Our goal is to make our academic and social learning spaces as comfortable as possible and to help our students feel at home in the classroom.

The Greenhouse and Garden:

This innovative space suggests a strong emphasis on experiential learning, offering opportunities for science education, environmental studies, and hands-on projects related to horticulture and sustainability. This environment can be particularly beneficial for kinesthetic learners and those who thrive in practical, applied settings.

The Red Barn Makerspace and Artspace:

This facility highlights the school's dedication to fostering creativity, innovation, and practical skills. The makerspace provides an environment for design thinking, engineering, and technological exploration, while the art space nurtures artistic expression and development. These spaces are invaluable for students who learn best through creation and hands-on engagement.
